
Parkway Condominiums brings much-needed EV chargers to Niagara Falls region

Niagara Falls is an international wonder and tourist attraction, but as of 2021 offered only two public locations where electric vehicles could charge. Parkway Condominiums Communications Director Lynnanne Baggott recognized the opportunity to "Get on the Map" as a charging destination and, with the support of the homeowners' association, they contracted with Livingston Energy Group to install four Livingston level 2 charging stations. The stations came online in January 2022.

Parkway chose the Livingston CP203 charger operating at 40 amps, 7.6 kW output. These chargers are open to the residents and the public and are supplying power at \$0.49 per kW hour, which generates revenue back to Parkway Condos.

Livingston Energy Group secured funding from local utility National Grid's Make-Ready Program at the full 90% program level. Parkway Condos paid the remainder of the installation costs. Livingston coordinated with National Grid to install a new overhead pole to carry the electrical service to the installation location.

Parkway chose to pre-pay Livingston Energy Group for five years of Tier 3 warranty service and maintenance, which also includes data reporting as required by the utility funding program.
